Перечень вопросов для проведения промежуточной аттестации по английскому языку в 8 классе

Промежуточная аттестация для обучающихся 8 класса проводится по учебному предмету «Иностранный язык (английский)» по итогам учебного года в форме устного экзамена по билетам.

Базовый уровень достижений, оценка «удовлетворительно» (отметка «3») — уровень, который демонстрирует освоение учебных действий с опорной системой знаний в рамках диапазона (круга) выделенных задач.

Превышение базового уровня свидетельствует об усвоении опорной системы знаний на уровне осознанного произвольного овладения учебными действиями, а также о кругозоре, широте (или избирательности) интересов. Целесообразно выделить следующие два уровня, превышающие базовый:

- **повышенный уровень** достижения планируемых результатов, оценка «хорошо» (отметка «4»);
- **высокий уровень** достижения планируемых результатов, оценка «отлично» (отметка «5»).

An obento, or bento, is one of the oldest food traditions in Japan. Basically, it is lunch served in a box.
